General Rules

- THE PASS IS NON-TRANSFERABLE.
- Seven Springs reserves the right to refuse any application.
- Applicants must have a Seven Springs Season Pass to obtain a NASTAR Season Pass or Seasonal Ski Check.

Ski and Snowboard Eligibility

- To qualify for the college pass you must be a full time student, ages 18-22, enrolled with at least 12 credit hours for the fall semester of 2010 and/ or the spring semester of 2011. College students must supply both a current college ID and a copy of their class schedule for the fall semester of 2010 at the time they pick up their pass. Not available for students in online or web-based universities.
- Junior rates apply to children who are between and including the ages of 12 - 17 at the time their pass is purchased.
- Child rates apply to children who are between and including the ages of 6 - 11 at the time their pass is purchased.
- Senior rates apply to individuals who are between and including ages of 65 - 69 when they purchase their pass.
- The Super Senior Pass is available to individuals who are between and including ages of 70 - 79 when they purchase their pass.
- The \$25 Full Ski and Snowboard Season Pass is available to children 5 and under and adults age 80 and older at the time they purchase their pass.

Ski and Snowboard Pass Rules

- The Platinum Pass is transferable, but may be used by only one person on the slopes at a time.
- Ski and Snowboard passes may be picked up starting Oct. 2, 2010.
- Hours are 9 a.m. 5 p.m., Sat. and Sun. and will be daily from 9 a.m. - 7 p.m. once the slopes are open.
- Your photo will be taken when you pick up your pass.
- YOU MUST HAVE PROPER IDENTIFICATION WITH YOU AT THAT TIME.
- There is no charge for the photo.
- DO NOT SEND PHOTOS.

- Season passes will not be issued until all information provided on this application is verified by the Seven Springs Season Pass Office staff.
- Your pass is good for all ski and snowboard sessions, except for the Midweek Pass, which is good any session Mon. through Thurs., excluding Dec. 27, 2010 - Dec. 30, 2010. The Midweek Pass will be valid for any session, any day after March 10, 2011.
- Seven Springs will not be responsible for contents of season lockers. We recommend using a #5 Master Padlock
- For everyone's safety, all skiers and snowboarders must obey The Responsibility Code and Seven Springs' area policies.
- Seven Springs reserves the right to suspend or revoke any ski and snowboard pass for violation of area policies without refund.
- Pass must be visible and identifiable when entering the lift line. You must show pass when asked by Seven Springs staff.
- · No defacing pass.
- Pass is valid Nov. 15, 2010, through the close of the season.
- Whoever would falsify, forge, counterfeit, alter or tamper with this Season Pass, or willfully allow any other person to have or to use it, or whoever impersonates the lawful person hereon shall be subject to local, state and federal laws.
- You must stop at the ticket booth and display pass for entrance to area.
- If your pass is lost or stolen, notify the Season Pass Office immediately.
- Please protect your pass as you would your cash or credit cards.
- Replacement allowed one time only, at our discretion, at a charge of \$25.

SEASON PASS RELEASE AND WAIVER AGREEMENT

In consideration for a season pass for use of ski slopes, lifts, terrain areas, and other facilities related to downhill skiing/ snow boarding issued by Seven Springs Farm, Inc., d/b/a Seven Springs Mountain Resort, its owners, officers, employees, agents, representatives, parents, and affiliates (hereinafter, "Seven Springs"), Lagree:

- (1) that I understand that there is a risk of serious injury or death if I participate in skiing or snow boarding. It would be impractical to list all the risks. Some of the risks include, falls caused by bare spots, variations in surface and subsurface snow an ice conditions, variations in terrain and terrain area features (table tops, ramps, half-pipes, rails, etc.), bumps, moguls, stumps, rocks, other forms of forest growth and debris. Risks also include collisions with other persons, lift towers, poles, cables, snow making equipment, snowmobiles, grooming machines, fences, barriers, and other natural and man made obstacles on and/or off of trails. Another risk is falls and collisions caused by the negligence of others, including Seven Springs. I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to follow the Skier Responsibility Code, all rules regarding terrain park use, and all other instructions, rules and directions provided by Seven Springs, and to exercise caution and remain in control while participating.
- (2) to accept all risks , whether specifically listed in paragraph (1) above or not, which arise out of or are related to the use of my season pass to ski or ride at Seven Springs.
- (3) that my season pass may be suspended or revoked, without reimbursement to me, if I do not follow the rules, instructions and directions of Seven Springs,
- (4) to waive my right to bring any claims against Seven Springs that arise out of or relate to my use of my season pass to ski or ride at Seven Springs, and to release Seven Springs from liability for any such claims. This waiver and release includes, but is not limited to, claims based upon allegations of negligence on the part of Seven Springs. I further agree that I will indemnify, hold harmless, and reimburse Seven Springs for all losses (including attorneys' fees and costs) from any claims brought by any persons or entities arising out of or relating to my use of my season pass to ski or ride at Seven Springs.
- (5) that the terms of this Agreement shall be binding on my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. I agree that all disputes arising under this Agreement shall be litigated in the Court of Common Pleas of Somerset County, Pennsylvania.
- (6) I grant Seven Springs permission to use photographic and/or video images of me for the purpose of marketing, publicizing and promoting the resort. I waive any right to be compensated for the use of my image and release Seven Springs from liability for any claims, where such claims arise out of or relate to Seven Springs' use of my image.
